117/022 Declaration of Interest

Resolved it be noted that no member declared any interest on items on the agenda

117/023 Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on the 10th January 2017

Resolved that the minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on the 10th January 2017 be confirmed as a true record and signed by the chairman

117/024 War Memorial

Clerk to go through the War Memorial letters & e-mails, to check why we have not yet received permission to erect the fence around the War memorial. Chairman Battersby reported we would need an archaeologist, to watch the erection of the fence this would be at a cost of £400.

117/025 Recycling Crown Hotel Eamont Bridge

Councillor Battersby will visit Mr Gardner of the Crown Hotel and request he does the necessary concreting of the recycling unit.

117/026 Dog Waste Bin Southwaite

Councillor Wright requested the parish council purchase a Dog Waste Bin. The Parish Council agreed to purchase The Retriever Dog Waste Bin, at a cost of £180-25 plus Vat from Glasdon Ltd. Delivery to be made to Councillor Wrights home.

117/027 Penrith Agricultural Show

Councillor Battersby reported a meeting had been held at his home between members of the Penrith show committee, Sergeant Tim Parkin & Councillor Battersby The Parish Council had expressed their concerns over the disturbance caused by a few person who attended the Penrith Show & on leaving the show caused problems through the village of Eamont Bridge . Sergeant Parkin agreed to have more police presence on the day of the show.

117/028 Van at Yanwath

Although the Parish Council has contacted the owner of the van, there has been no response. Clerk to seek advice from CALC solicitor.

*117/029 Condition of the road Green Lane Southwaite
Councillor Wright reported Green Lane Southwaite was in need of repair & re surfing . Clerk to write to Cumbria County Council, to request they carry out the necessary work.*

*117/030 Land at Glendowlin
Mr Toby Hadley completed his project for the Eden River Trust at the Hidey Hole Yanwath. Mr Hadley felled some trees & tidied the Hidey Hole. The wood that Mr Hadley had felled from the trees he planned to make into a bench, however a parishioner from Yanwath, removed the wood before Mr Hadley could collect. The chairman had given permission for the parishioner to remove the wood. The Parish Council have suggested if Mr Hadley wishes to fell a further tree & then take the wood this would be acceptable to the Parish Council. Mr Hadley would require the necessary insurance to do the work.*

*117031 Telephone Kiosk Eamont Bridge
The Parish Council has received a reply from BT Telephones. They no longer own the kiosk. The Eamont Bridge telephone kiosk was adopted by the Community Heartbeat Trust on the 15th September 2015. Clerk to write to the Community Heartbeat Trust and request they arrange for the telephone box to be removed.*

*117/032 106 Partnership
A leaflet will be delivered to the parishioners of the parish requested they complete a questionnaire*

*117/033 M6 Bridge Southwaite Green
Councillor Wright reported his concern about the structure of the bridge over the M6 ,south of the junction 40. Councillor Wright showed photographs he had taken of the bridge. Clerk instructed to write to Cumbria County Highways expressing the concerns of the parish council, photographs of the bridge to be enclosed.*

*117/034 Parish Council Vacancy
Councillor Thoele has volunteered to speak to a parishioner of Yanwath,, who he believes may consider becoming a parish councillor.*

The Cumbria Heartbeat Trust has managed to obtain a grant for two defibrillators. The defibrillators are to be installed within the parish.1. To be sited at Eamont Bridge Village Hall 2. To be sited in the telephone box Yanwath*
